

FTA Drug and Alcohol Management Information System

2016 Results Summary



Required Testing Program

Covered employees must undergo DOT testing for five illegal substances, and for alcohol, with the use of six different test types. Employers are required to establish a program that provides for testing employees who perform or may perform safety-sensitive functions in the following circumstances: pre-employment, random, reasonable suspicion, post-accident, return-to-duty, and follow-up.

Covered Employees and Employers

A covered employee is any person, including an applicant, transferee, or volunteer, who performs or will perform a safety-sensitive function for any entity subject to Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 655.

A covered employer is a recipient or other entity that provides public transportation service or performs a safety-sensitive function for such recipient or other entity. This includes recipients of funding from the Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Program, 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program, 5309 Fixed Guideway Capital Investment Grants, and 5311 Formula Grants for Rural Program. It also includes subrecipients and contractors.



2016 Positive Rate and Violation Rate

Positive rate for random drug testing means the number of verified positive results for random drug tests plus the number of refusals of random drug tests, divided by the total number of random drug test results (i.e., positive, negative, and refusals).

Violation rate for random alcohol testing means the number of 0.04 and above random alcohol confirmation test results plus the number of refusals of random alcohol tests, divided by the total number of alcohol random screening tests (including refusals).
